Staff/Key workers

You will be introduced to your child's key person. Your child's key person will work closely with your child throughout the day. If you have any problems or concerns please do not hesitate to inform your child's key person to resolve any problems.

Clothing

The children will have access to a wide range of activities, for them to choose from which will be indoors and outdoors. So it is essential that *ALL* the children are wearing suitable clothing, footwear and head wear. Whilst at Grass Hopperz C.I.C your children will be exposed to new experiences, such as messy play for exp. (dirt/foam). So you are advised to put your child(ren) in clothing that you will not mind if it gets dirty, we will provide children with suitable protective clothing where needed exp. (Aprons)

Here are some suggestions of suitable footwear/head wear/ appropriate clothing that maybe required within the setting:-

- **Trainers/pumps (labelled with your child's name)**

- Swimming costume and towel (labelled with your childs name)
- Spare clothing and footwear (labelled with your childs name)
- Sun hats/Sun cream/Cap/Wooly hat (labelled with your childs name)
- Sun cream (labelled with your childs name)
- Warm coats (labelled with your childs name)
- Gloves/Scarves (labelled with your childs name)
- Appropriate clothing (Labelled with your childs name, clothes that you do not mind getting messy)

Indoor environment

Grass Hopperz C.I.C will plan a wide range of activities such as (Cooking/Arts and crafts/Sensory and Music. All the activities will be planned using the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS), this is to ensure that all the children's areas of development are being met and that the children are engaged and stimulated.

Outdoor environment

The holiday playscheme will also have a variety of planned activities such as a wide range of Sport activities for exp. football, netball and many more, as well as a wide range of Outdoor team building game activities. The activities will also be planned using the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS), this is to ensure that the children are learning whilst being engaged in fun activities to enhance your child's development.

Club Policies

Below is a breakdown of the Early Years Foundation Stage

(EYFS)

Communication and Language

(Listening and attention/Understanding/Speaking)

Encourages children to become a unique child in the way they respond to situations such as stories being read to them or how they respond to various sounds they hear. Encourages children to build positive relationships, between the child and staff members to develop a close bond so that the adult can meet the child's learning needs. Which also enables the child to be exposed to new learning experiences to promote effective communication and language skills.

Maths

Maths is one of the main four areas within the EYFS. The children will understand to count and the value of numbers. Maths is a vital skill that will enable them to be able to problem solve, use money and calculate independently.

Shape, Space and measure are skills that children need to understand such as weight, capacity, size, position, distance, time and money

Physical

(Moving and Handling/Health and Self-care)

Encourages the children to become a unique child, build positive relationships and access resources in the environment. This is to enable children to become active learners listen to instructions and rules of new games, such as activities that requires the use of all of their body parts and muscles referring to sport or energetic activities.

Personal , Social and Emotional

Is one of the three prime areas within the EYFS. Children will develop self-confidence and self-awareness by developing new relationships to be able to try new activities and interact with new people, by sharing ideas and thoughts openly in a group. Learn how to express themselves appropriately and respect others beliefs.

Literacy

Reading along with writing makes up Literacy. Literacy is one of the four specific areas within the EYFS. The enables children to read and understand simple sentences, by using phonic knowledge this can be done by reading books, shared reading or singing nursery rhymes.

Understanding of the world

Is one of the four specific areas of learning within the EYFS. This allows support for children to understand their physical world and their community, this is done by children being exposed to explore, observe and find out about people in the world and their environment.

What to do at home

Please spend 5- 10 minutes to communicate with your child, ask them how their day was at Grass Hopperz C.I.C. Allow your child to become independent learners at home, as this gets your child ready for their life journey to have a successful and prosperous future.
